Barrel Aging – how do you track this task?

Barrel aging is a tool for effectively enhancing many of the already good products produced. Simply by adding the wine to a barrel and allowing it age even further is great value, but how do you track it in **WMS Plus**? Here's how:

Create the Invoice:

- **Enter wine** – add the wine to the details section of an invoice.

- **Enter Comments** – in the field at the end of the line where the wine has been added, enter the comment, “**Barrel Age**” (you may have to use the horizontal scroll bar to move the right to full view this column in order to type).

Print the Production Label from:

- **Invoice Report Selector**
- **Wines To Make (Shft-F6)**
- **Output** – note that the Barrel Age comments show at the bottom of the label for staff to be aware this is a barrel aged product.

Edit the Bottle Date by:

- **Filter Checklist** – when the filtering is done, next the wine is due to be bottled, but the **Barrel Age** comment is displayed on the label and checklist.
- **Extend the Bottle Date** – using the pop up calendar in F6 or Verify in Production, change the **Bottled** date to the expected removal of the wine from the barrel. This will be retained in WMS for future task reminder.
